Just a reminder to anybody in need of new equipment, the BWC Grants are a great way to save a ton of money! We have received many new pieces of equipment through this grant. We have purchased scissor lifts indoor/outdoor, undercarriage wash units (Enzo's), various cleaning machines for buses or bathrooms and the newest piece of equipment....portable plasma cutter!

For those not familiar with the BWC or Bureau of Workers compensation, they have safety grants and if they approve an item you are interested in purchasing, they will pay \$3 to every \$1 you pay. I like to share this info because budgets are real people!
